



System Recommendations

This document lists the system resource recommendations for evaluation and production use of the MOVEit Central file transfer management super-client software by Standard Networks. (A separate similar document is available for the MOVEit DMZ secure file transfer server software.)

MOVEit Central is a Windows-based enterprise-level file transfer management client that can automatically pull, process, and push files on a scheduled, event-driven or ad hoc basis. MOVEit Central runs as a service and is used to move files between internal and external hosts, including MOVEit DMZ servers. It does this with easy-to-create tasks (no programming required).

Tasks make use of the MOVEit Central secure HTTP (HTTPS), secure FTP over SSL (FTPS) and secure FTP over SSH2 (SFTP/SCP2) transfer capabilities, and its ability to do FTP, copy to the local file system and shared network folders, and send/receive email and attachments using SMTP/POP3. Tasks can also process files using built-in Central functions, including its commercially licensed OpenPGP encryption option and bundled S/MIME encryption object, as well as with VBS scripts.

MOVEit Central does not require a dedicated host, but can benefit from one. Minimum hardware and software system resource recommendations for evaluation and production are shown below.

¹ Pricing does not vary based on the number of CPUs on the system that hosts MOVEit Central.

² MOVEit Central can be run under Microsoft Virtual Server or under VMware by EMC Corporation.

MOVEit Central includes a Windows application called MOVEit Central Admin that can be used to configure, control and monitor Central on the host system or remotely over an SSL-encrypted link. Central Admin runs on Windows XP Professional as well as on Windows 2003 and 2000 Server.

Depending on use, the MOVEit Central host system may benefit from or need additional resources, including faster or additional CPU's, more RAM and/or hard drive capacity, or an SSL accelerator.
